## SHAMBALA PRESERVE SAFARI RESERVATION

One special weekend each month, The SHAMBALA PRESERVE opens its gates to the public for its series of exciting and informative "safaris" through the world of the big cats, all of whom are an endangered or threatened species. You may see African lions, Bengal and Siberian tigers, black and spotted

leopards, servals and mountain lions.

You need not be a triathlete to join our Safaris, but you should have a reasonable degree of general walking fitness and agility. The Safari venue and tour are not strenuous, but there are no paved paths and the terrain is in its natural state - this is better for the Wild Ones. You will be walking on uneven dirt ground and you may be stepping over rocks and shrubs, or stepping around local snakes, lizards, or other indigenous wildlife. If you are unsure whether a Safari will be comfortable for you, please contact us with questions.

Our safaris fill up quickly, so please send in your reservation at least one month in advance.

The afternoon Safari consists of a 2 1/2 hour (max) planned program, including a 1 hour guided walk through. Sign in begins at 11:30AM, and the Gates open at noon. You can bring a small snack and drink to enjoy after the walk. (Out of respect to the animals, we ask that you do not eat during your walk through.)

To avoid unnecessary expense, no tickets will be mailed. Please wear flat shoes and long pants. Do not wear shorts.

Photos can be taken for personal use only.

I also understand that there will be no refunds, but I may re-schedule my visit for a different day by notifying The Roar Foundation at least 7 days prior to my originally scheduled event.

All visitors must be at least 18 years old.

Pets are not allowed on the property and may not be left in vehicles.

Private safaris on other dates may be arranged for groups of 35 or more persons. Please phone for details!
