Our safaris fill up quickly, so please send in your reservation at least one month in advance.

Our guided tours last approximately three (3) hours and begin promptly at noon. Sign in begins at 11:30AM, and the Gates open at noon. The tour culminates at Lake Shambala. You can bring a picnic lunch to enjoy after the tour. (Out of respect to the animals, we ask that you do not eat while on the tour.)

To avoid unnecessary expense, no tickets will be mailed or confirmed by phone. Please wear flat shoes and long pants. Do not wear shorts.

Bring a camera for personal use only.

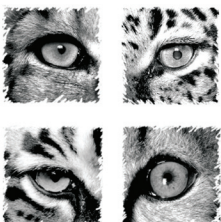
